A CHILD IS BORN!

The last couple of weeks of our Gatherings have focused on the birth of a child. Let's begin with reviewing and reading together about the birth of John, the forerunner of Jesus:

Luke 1:5-17; 57-79

The Birth of John

John was the one who would prepare people to accept Jesus as their savior and king. How is our role during this season similar to John?

Now, let's remind ourselves of the next birth, by reading about the birth of Jesus:

Matthew 1:18-24

The Birth of Jesus

Why is the birth of Jesus so important for us?

And now, let's talk about the next child to be born. This child can only be born because Jesus was born and came to be with us, to be one of us, and to give up his life for all of us. The birth we are talking about is the second birth, the spiritual birth as a child of God. The child we are talking about is **YOU!**

Let's read these passages and remind ourselves of the incredible birth we have when we give our lives to Christ:

John 1:10-13 Galatians 4:4-5

What does it mean to you that you have been born all over again, as a child of God?
